The requested information is held centrally however due to a change in the incident reporting system used by the Trust it is not possible to extract the information requested as a standalone piece of data. In order to extract the requested information and collate the results would require a manual exercise to identify and review incident records and would exceed the appropriate time limits, as per the Freedom of Information Act 2000 section 12(1) which does not oblige a public authority to comply with a request for information if the authority estimates that the cost of complying with the request would exceed the appropriate limit.

How many mixed sex communal areas and mixed sex wards are in operation at the trust?

Therefore, in order to extract the requested information and collate the results would require a manual exercise to identify and review incident records and would exceed the appropriate time limits, as per the Freedom of Information Act 2000 section 12(1) which does not oblige a public authority to comply with a request for information if the authority estimates that the cost of complying with the request would exceed the appropriate limit.
