They are completed in line with the National Standards Of Healthcare Cleanliness 2021. Each location within the Trust is given a Functional Risk Rating which determines the frequency in which they are audited. Each element within a room is scored a pass or fail and an overall score is given after 50% of the area has been audited.
