Request for Information

I write further to your request FOI ID 50941 under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 regarding: -

Lease cars

Your request is set out below:

I am writing to request a vehicle fleet list operated by the Trust, whether owned or leased. I would appreciate it if you could provide the following details for each vehicle:

- Chassis Make and Model
- Registration Mark of each motor vehicle (VRM)
- Date of acquisition
- Date of disposal (if applicable) for vehicles decommissioned between 2020 and 2025

Please find attached table which provides the make, model, Date of acquisition and vehicle decommission date.

The Trust are unable to release the registration number of each of these vehicles as this is deemed to be personal data by both the DVLA and the Information Commissioners Office. By releasing this information into the public domain, it could identify an individual who is carrying out their organisational public duties. Therefore, under Section 40(2), by way of section 40(3A)(a) personal data of any person (third party data) is exempt under section 40(2) if disclosure would breach one of the data protection principles. This aspect of Section 40 is an Absolute Exemption. It is therefore subject to the provisions of the UK Data Protection Act (2018). We believe that to disclose this would be likely to breach the first Principle of the Data Protection Act by unfairly contravening right to privacy and confidentiality. In addition, we do not believe there is any public interest in the release of this data which would outweigh our relevant legislative requirements.

I confirm that the information above completes your request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000. I am also pleased to confirm that no charge will be made for this request.
