External Placement Guidelines (Clinical Skills)

During the external placement the trainee may be placed within an organisation different to the one they are employed by. The placement may operate quite differently and as a result trainee will only be permitted to perform certain clinical skills if their Practice Assessor considers them competent to do so. THE TRAINEE HAS A DUTY TO IDENTIFY IF THEY HAVE NOT BEEN TRAINED OR ARE NOT CONFIDENT TO UNDERTAKE TASK.

The following list has been designed to guide trainees and supervisors, it is not exhaustive and if there is any uncertainty regarding a clinical skill the work-based learning facilitator should be contacted for advice:
