Please break these figures down by the number of referrals received, the number of referrals accepted and the number of referrals responded to with advice and guidance or support, with the recorded reason for declination. The Kent and Medway NHS and Social Care Partnership Trust do provide memory assessments however, in order to provide the requested information would require a manual exercise to identify and review clinical records and would exceed the appropriate time limits, as per the Freedom of Information Act 2000 section 12(1) which does not oblige a public authority to comply with a request for information if the authority estimates that the cost of complying with the request would exceed the appropriate limit.

2. Details of any policy change regarding altered thresholds for referrals, altered access to pathways or triage systems and documentation outlining the change (and reasoning of the change if available) as regards referrals to each of the below services/pathways.

In relation to the CRHT pathway the team now offers a clearer two core functions, Rapid Response and Home Treatment, both currently under the umbrella of CRHT.

- Rapid Response offers 4hrs to assess someone and the Trust has employed additional call
 handlers to facilitate assessments countywide with each CRHT offering dedicated staff
 resource on a daily basis (24/&7). The RR clinicians will determine if someone requires
 admission or home treatment support if community support is not available or suitable.
- The Home Treatment Team now operates an extended daily service although not 24/7.

In relation to the Memory Assessment pathway the Trust are currently completing a review of the memory assessment pathway with the aim, as per the NHS Long-Term Plan, to diagnose 95% of patients within six weeks.
